Plenary sessions will be delivered in the main conference room, Concurrent sessions are presented orally. Presenters are expected to deliver a maximum 30 minute paper including discussion and any questions. There is a prize for the best presentation.

Poster Presentations

These are visual displays that are presented and displayed throughout the duration of the conference proceedings and provide an opportunity to disseminate information to all the delegates. There will be an opportunity to present your poster to a small panel. There will be a prize for the best poster and this will be presented on Sunday Morning.



Workshops

Workshops are interactive sessions of around 45 minute's duration, where the leader of the session will work with the participants to develop their knowledge and understanding with a specific field. Workshops are presented by an expert within the field.

Conference fees

Prices start at £180 for BANN members and £220 for non-members for the 2 1/2 days, which includes the conference dinner, drinks reception and entertainment on the Saturday night.
